#### **Piano Competition**

Calling all pianists! It doesn't matter if you have lessons inside or outside of school, you can all enter this year's EMS piano competition. Auditions will take place after school on Monday 24th June and Tuesday 25th June, also at the United Reformed Church.

The competition consists of two categories for Primary Schools: Primary School Grades 2-3 and Primary School Grades 4. There will be a prize of £50 for the winners and £10 for the runners-up in each category. The minimum entry requirement is Grade 2 for primary school pupils and it is not necessary to have passed any exams, but the piece performed must be the required grade or higher. The level of the piece presented will determine the category entered. Pupils need to perform one piece at the audition.
