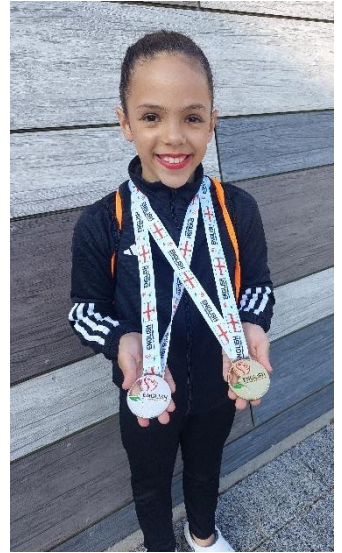
Aim High and Be Kind
